

Call to Worship

One: On the road between what is safe and what is just, we gather as travelers and truth-seekers.

One: Christ is not found in the halls of power, but in the ditch, broken and waiting.

All: It moves us toward the wounded, toward the margins, toward one another.

One: Here we are reminded that justice is not an idea—it is what love looks like in public.

One: We are here not to escape the world's pain, but to be transformed by love into healers of it.

All: Let us worship the God of justice and mercy, who meets us in the ditch and sends us out to serve.

Help us to see you in the stranger, to kneel in solidarity, and to rise in service. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.
